

Dear Families,

I can't believe we are almost at the end of the school year! I wanted to inform you of the important information regarding our field trip to **Cooperstown on Tuesday, June 22nd**.

9:00 bathroom break and attendance

9:15 bus departs Bell for Cooperstown

11:30 arrive at the Farmer's Museum, get in our small assigned groups for museum exploration

12:30-1:00 Lunch (Don't forget to send a bagged lunch for your child, if they have not ordered one from school).

1:00-2:30 more museum exploration

2:30 meet for bathroom break

2:45 board bus

3:00 departure

5:15-5:30ish arrive at Bell. Please, families, try to be at school ready for pick-up by 5:30.

Commonly asked questions by the students regarding the field trip:

1. Q: Can we eat on the bus? A: Only if bus driver allows it.
2. Q: Can we bring electronics? A: Bring at your own risk. Leaving unattended equipment on the bus is not recommended. Students will need to carry their own belongings throughout the museum. We do not recommend bringing valuables, because we cannot guarantee their safety.
3. Q: Can we shop at the gift shop? A: Some small groups may have time to visit the museum gift shop. But I feel that we are there to experience the museum and not to shop. So, there may only be a few (if any) minutes to shop.
4. Q: Should I bring money? A: There are some candy, soda and ice cream stands. Most likely it will be hot and a treat might be nice. I don't

recommend anyone bring more than \$5.00 for a treat. No one **needs** to bring additional money though. It is optional!
